On October 19th, the Fauquier County Chamber of Commerce hosted its inaugural “Virtual Bus Tour” to present commercial and industrial development opportunities within Fauquier County. Carson/ Ashley was an event sponsor and Jim Carson, President of Carson/ Ashley and a Chamber Board member, co-hosted the presentation to more than 120 people attending the event. The presentation highlighted key development related information for 77 properties currently available for lease or purchase in nine developing areas of the County. The Chamber intends to work with its membership to keep the opportunity list current and plans for the “tour” to be an annual event.
